Plans for the development of the west side of the campus will be moving forward within the next few weeks. More details will be forthcoming on this project. We look forward to expanding our fields and playground areas.

We have to continue to invest in the upkeep of the buildings, which for many years we have not done, and are now playing some catch up to keep them in good shape to save money and maintain our facilities in the long run.
