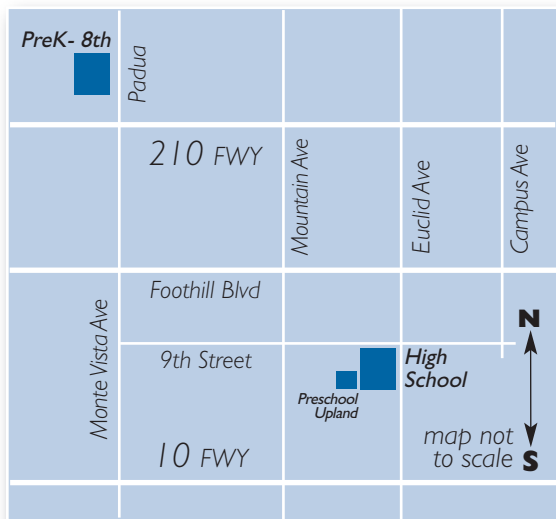

Summer School Policies:

1. WCHS International Summer Program offers a 6 week program from June 20 to July 28, 2011. Each class is equivalent to 2 semesters at 5 units each totaling 10 units.
2. All students will abide by the WCHS Student-Parent Handbook.
3. Dress Code: Appropriate summer attire (refer to WCHS Student-Parent Handbook).
4. NO COURSE CREDIT will be given if a student is absent more than TWO days per session. Three (3) tardies equal 1 day absent.
5. ALL STUDENTS MUST TAKE AND PASS FINAL EXAMS TO RECEIVE COURSE CREDIT.
6. Report Cards will be mailed to address on the registration form.
7. A fee of \$75.00 will be charged on ALL returned checks and must be paid in cash prior to student attending class.
